



## 2023 Summer Employment Opportunity

The Town of Niverville is now accepting applications for Summer Camp Leaders to work during the months of July and August. These positions require split shift flexibility; hours will be Monday to Friday with varied shifts for an estimated 20-40 hours per week. Reporting to the Camps & Recreation Programmer, the successful applications will be required to:

- Provide a fun, positive and safe environment for all children;
- Be responsible for the safety and well-being of each child;
- Guide daily activities with children in Summer Day Camp Program;
- Supervise and provide leadership for children participating in the program;
- Work cooperatively with other staff;
- Be prepared to work outside or inside;
- Communicate with parents and/or guardians where appropriate/as required; and
- Administrative and other duties as assigned.

Conditions of employment include the following:

- Satisfactory Child Abuse Registry Check;
- CPR/First Aid Certification;
- Valid Class 5 Driver's Licence;
- Access to a vehicle;
- At least 16 years of age; and
- Valid social insurance number.
